Activity 1. Development of the theoretical-practical content of the Values Toolbox

With the aim of developing a toolbox that adapts to the real needs of the migrant population, a survey was carried out on the situation of the four chosen values in their country of origin and their current country of residence. The survey was taken by 33 people in the three cities participating in the project (12 in Cordoba, 11 in Dublin and 10 in Malaga).

Conclusions

Below are the main conclusions of the Field Researchs.

European Values - General questions

- In average, those surveyed rated their knowledge about the European Values a 5.58/10.
- About 56% of them agree that the EU promotes and protects European Values.
- Those surveyed rated the EU's performance in ensuring equal opportunities and non-discrimination a 5.6/10.



Equality

- 30.3% of those surveyed think that men and women get paid the same amount for the same job.
- 44% agreed that the access to democracy and government is equally available for both men and women.
- 80% consider that both men and women have equal access to healthcare.
- Those surveyed rated equality's importance as a European Value a 9.64/10.

Human Rights

- 30% agree that members of LGBTQ+ community are treated fairly in their country of origin.
- About 28% think that minority faiths and members of minority ethnic communities are treated equally.
- 39% think that members of the disability community are treated equally.



Freedom

- 57% consider that their country of origin has freedom of speech
- 65% agree that their country has freedom of assembly
- 57% think that their country of origin has freedom of information
- 73% believe their country has freedom of movement

Democracy

- 47% of those surveyed think their country of origin has fair elections
- 16 of those surveyed agreed that anyone can put themselves forward for election, while 13 didn't know or didn't answer.
- 39% believe the selection process for employment in their countries is fair and transparent
- 33% think the interactions with local government are fair and transparent.
